8 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-30-116 is created to read:

10 11-30-116. Damage to farm products and livestock.

- 12 (a) In addition to any other remedy allowable by law,
- 13 any person who, by willful or wanton misconduct, damages or
- 14 destroys any farm product or livestock used for testing or
- 15 research in conjunction with a product development program
- 16 for a private research facility, a university, a community
- 17 college or any federal, state or local governmental agency

1	shall	be	liable	for	damages	as	assessed	bv	the	court.	The

- 2 court shall determine the damage associated with the loss
- of the tests or research and award double the damages as
- 4 well as double the cost directly related to raising the
- 5 farm product or livestock. The court may assess costs of
- litigation and reasonable attorney fees. 6

(b) As used in this section: 8

- 10 (i) "Farm products" means all crops, crop
- products, plants or portions thereof; 11

- (ii) "Livestock" means horses, mules, cattle, 13
- 14 swine, sheep, goats, poultry, guard animals or any other
- animal maintained under domestication. Bison are considered 15
- livestock unless otherwise designated by the Wyoming 16
- 17 livestock board and the Wyoming game and fish commission.

19 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2002.
