AN ACT relating to state officials' salaries; increasing the salaries for state elected officials; providing for current salaries; providing appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

**Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-101(a)(i) through (v) is amended to read:

### 9-3-101. Salaries; amount; date of payment.

- (a) Salaries for clerk of the supreme court and district court reporters shall be determined by the supreme court as authorized by legislative appropriations. Subject to constitutional limitations the following state officers and members of the judiciary shall receive the salaries indicated by the figures following their respective titles:
  - (i) Governor......<del>\$95,000.00</del> \$105,000.00
  - (ii) Secretary of state....\$77,000.00 \$92,000.00
  - (iii) State auditor.....\$77,000.00 \$92,000.00
  - (iv) State treasurer......\$77,000.00 \$92,000.00

#### Section 2.

(a) Until such time as the salaries provided by section 1 of this act become effective, the following salary schedule shall apply:

- (a) For the period beginning January 7, 2003 through June 30, 2004, there is appropriated from the general fund to the governor's office sixteen thousand nine hundred five dollars (\$16,905.00) to implement the purposes of W.S. 9-3-101(a)(i), as amended by this act.
- (b) For the period beginning January 7, 2003 through June 30, 2004, there is appropriated from the general fund twenty-six thousand ninety-two dollars (\$26,092.00) to implement the purposes of W.S. 9-3-101(a) (ii) through (v), as amended by this act, to each of the following:
  - (i) The state auditor's office;
  - (ii) The state treasurer's office;
- (iii) The superintendent of public instruction's
  office;
  - (iv) The secretary of state's office.
