1 (a) As used in this article: 2 3 (i) "Electric utility" means any electrical 4 company or electric cooperative that is engaged in the 5 business of distributing electricity to retail electric customers in the state; 6 7 (ii) "Lighting apparatus" means any 8 shield, 9 cover or other device used with or on a lamp; 10 11 (iii) "Light trespass" means light emitted by a 12 lamp that shines beyond the boundaries of the property on which the lamp fixture is located. 13 14 15 37-16-202. Tariffs for outdoor lighting. 16 17 All electric utilities shall offer tariffs for utility provided outdoor lighting that provide an option for all 18 electric customers to choose lighting apparatus designed to 19 minimize light trespass and maintain dark skies. Rates for 20 21 these lighting apparatus shall not be subsidized by revenue 22 from other utility provided services. The commission shall have jurisdiction over the tariffs. 23 24
