6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 9-2-1022 by creating a new subsection

(n) is amended to read:

9-2-1022. Duties of department performed through

human resources division.

(n) The state compensation plan shall provide that,

upon separation from state employment, a state employee or

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1	the beneficiary of a deceased employee shall receive
2	payment, at the employee's rate of pay at separation, for
3	the current balance of unused sick leave not to exceed
4	payment for four hundred eighty (480) hours, subject to
5	subsection (e) of this section. If the employee is
6	participating in the state employees' and officials' group
7	insurance plan, any unused sick leave in excess of nine
8	hundred sixty (960) hours shall be treated as converted
9	sick leave and shall be reimbursed at the rate of one (1)
10	month's contribution by the state on behalf of the employee
11	to the state employees' and officials' group insurance plan
12	for each eight (8) hours of unused sick leave in excess of
13	nine hundred sixty (960) hours until the converted sick
14	leave is exhausted or the employee becomes eligible for
15	Medicare under Title XVIII of the federal Social Security
16	Act, whichever first occurs.

18	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
