Funding for multi-lane highways.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;

2 modifying the distribution of federal mineral royalties and

3 severance taxes as specified; distributing specified

4 federal mineral royalties and severance taxes to an account

5 within the highway fund; restricting use of account funds

6 to the construction and maintenance of multi-lane state

7 highways; providing a definition; conforming provisions;

8 and providing for an effective date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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Section 1. W.S. 9-4-601(a)(intro) and by creating a

13 new subsection (k), 9-4-602(a) by creating a new paragraph

(iv), 24-1-119 and 39-14-801(b), (c) (intro), (d) (intro) and

15 by creating a new subsection (e) are amended to read:

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9-4-601. Distribution and use; funds, accounts, cities and towns benefited; exception for bonus payments.

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4 (a) All monies received by the state of Wyoming from 5 the secretary of the treasury of the United States under the provisions of the act of congress of February 25, 1920 6 (41 Stat. 437, 450; 30 U.S.C. §§ 181, 191), as amended, or 7 from lessees or authorized mine operators and all monies 8 9 received by the state from its sale of production from 10 federal mineral leases subject to the act of congress of 11 February 25, 1920 (41 Stat. 437, 450; 30 U.S.C. §§ 181, 12 191) as amended, except as provided by subsection (b) of 13 this section, shall be deposited in the trust and agency 14 fund, then distributions under subsection (k) of this section shall be made and thereafter, the first two hundred 15 16 million dollars (\$200,000,000.00) of revenues received in 17 any fiscal year shall be distributed by the state treasurer as provided in this subsection. One percent (1%) of these 18 the two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000.00) in 19 20 revenues shall be credited to the general fund as 21 administrative fee, and the remainder shall be distributed 22 as follows:

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1 (k) Subject to the provisions of W.S. 9-4-602(a)(iv), after making any distributions required to make payments on 2 3 bonds issued under W.S. 9-4-605(b) prior to July 1, 2003 or 4 issued to refund bonds issued before July 1, 2003 and 5 funded by revenues specified under W.S. 9-4-605(a), and before making any other distribution under subsection (a) 6 7 or (d) of this section, seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00) per year shall be deposited into the multi-8 9 lane highway account within the state highway fund under W.S. 24-1-119(b). The one percent (1%) administrative fee 10 to be paid to the general fund provided for pursuant to 11 subsection (a) of this section shall 12 not apply 13 distributions under this subsection. 14 15 9-4-602. Distribution and use; state treasurer's 16 duty. 17 (a) Except as hereafter provided, distribution under 18 W.S. 9-4-601 shall be made by the state treasurer within 19 20 thirty (30) days after the receipt of the government 21 royalty funds for the preceding period. Federal mineral

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royalties received by the state on a continuing monthly

basis shall be distributed under W.S. 9-4-601 by the state

1 treasurer, subject to the following and except as otherwise

2 provided by law for fiscal year 1994:

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4 (iv) Federal mineral royalties to be distributed

5 under W.S. 9-4-601(k) to the multi-lane highway account

within state highway fund under W.S. 24-1-119(b) shall be 6

7 made in equal monthly amounts.

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24-1-119. State highway fund created; 9 income and expenditure. 10

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12 There is created a fund known as the 13 highway fund, to the credit of which the state treasurer, who is designated as the state official to receive all 14 amounts paid by the United States under the act of congress 15 approved July 11, 1916, shall place all monies previously 16 received for the fund, all money subsequently received from 17 States, under cooperative agreements 18 the United authorized, all money derived from taxes levied for such 19 20 purpose or appropriated for the fund, all monies received 21 from the sale of state bonds for highway construction or 22 improvement, all money received from the counties under cooperative agreements as hereinbefore authorized, and all 23 other monies received from donations or bequests, which may 24

be accepted by the commission on behalf of the state of 1 2 Wyoming, or from any source designated by law for that 3 purpose. Except as provided in subsection (b) of this 4 section, all monies in the fund shall be available for the 5 purpose of this act without further appropriation and no warrant shall be drawn on the fund excepting on a voucher 6 7 director of approved by the the department transportation or an assistant authorized by the director 8 9 and approved by the transportation commission. It 10 provided that seventy-five percent (75%) of the amount of 11 any bond issue subsequently issued by the state of Wyoming 12 for the construction or improvement of state highways, 13 after the payment of overhead expense, shall be apportioned to and spent in each county in the proportion which the 14 assessed valuation of each county by the last general 15 16 assessment bears to the total assessment of the state.

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(b) A multi-lane highway account shall be established within the state highway fund. Funds within the account shall be available as provided in subsection (a) of this section except that they shall be used solely for the purposes of construction and maintenance of multi-lane state highways within the state. For purposes of this section "multi-lane" means more than two (2) lanes.

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39-14-801. Severance tax distributions; distribution
account created; formula.

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5 (b) [LUST] Before making distributions from the severance tax distribution account under subsections (c), 6 and (d) and (e) of this section, an amount equal to the 7 amount of tax collected under W.S. 39-17-104(c) and 8 9 39-17-204(b) for the same period shall be distributed to 10 the corrective action account created by W.S. 35-11-1424 and to the financial responsibility account created by W.S. 11 35-11-1427 in an inverse proportion to the amount in the 12 13 two (2) accounts.

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(c) After making distributions under subsection 15 subsections (b) and (e) of this section, distributions 16 17 under subsection (d) of this section shall be made from the severance tax distribution account. The 18 amount of distributions under subsection (d) of this section shall 19 20 one hundred fifty-five million dollars exceed 21 (\$155,000,000.00) in any fiscal year. To the extent that 22 distributions under subsection (d) of this section would 23 exceed that amount in any fiscal year, the excess shall be 24 credited:

(a) of this section shall be distributed as follows, 3

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7 (e) Before making distributions from the severance

tax distribution account under subsections (c) and (d) of 8

9 this section, seven million dollars (\$7,000,000.00) per

year shall be deposited into the multi-lane highway account 10

12 Distributions of revenues under this subsection shall be

13 made in equal quarterly amounts.
