Public service commission-utility assessments.

A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to public utilities; modifying uniform
- 2 assessment dates; providing for a transition payment; and
- 3 providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-2-107 is amended to read:

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- 9 37-2-107. Uniform assessment regarding
- 10 telecommunications, gas, electric, water and pipeline
- 11 service; assessment generally.

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- 13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
- 14 section, on or before the first day of March July of each
- 15 year the director of revenue shall, by requiring special
- 16 reports or otherwise, determine the total aggregate amount
- 17 of the gross Wyoming intrastate retail revenues of all

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1 public utilities, entities utilizing public utility 2 furnish retail facilities in the state to utility 3 commodities or services to the public, and providers of 4 telecommunication services, except motor carriers, 5 those utilities exempted under W.S. 37-2-108, for the preceding calendar year. He shall then determine the ratio 6 that one-half (1/2) of the total authorized budgeted amount 7 for the biennium is to the total aggregate gross retail 8 9 Wyoming intrastate operating revenues. The resulting 10 percentage factor shall then be applied to the annual 11 intrastate gross retail operating revenues of each of such persons for the preceding calendar year and the result 12 13 shall be the assessment of each such person for the ensuing 14 budget fiscal year. However, the assessment rate against the persons for any one (1) year shall not exceed .0030 of 15 16 Wyoming intrastate retail revenues of the gross 17 persons. By the first day of April August the director of the revenue department shall assess the persons, and one-18 19 half (1/2) the assessed fees shall be paid to him by the 20 persons on or before the first day of June October and one-21 half (1/2) of the fees shall be paid to him by the persons 22 on or before the first day of December April in the ensuing 23 year. The director of the revenue department, in computing 24 the percentage upon which fees for the first fiscal year of

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1 the ensuing biennium shall be based, shall deduct any 2 unexpended balance in the commission's account within the 3 earmarked revenue fund, less an amount equal to the total 4 of all properly authorized outstanding accounts payable, 5 from one-half (1/2) the total authorized budgeted amount for the biennium, and the resultant figure shall be used 6 7 instead of the one-half (1/2) of the total authorized budgeted amount for the biennium, as above provided. Any 8 9 unexpended balance in the commission's account within the 10 earmarked revenue fund shall not lapse at the end of the 11 fiscal period. "Intrastate gross retail operating revenues" 12 used in this section shall mean intrastate gross 13 revenues derived from the provision of telecommunications, 14 gas, electric, water and pipeline service offered for final consumption and not for resale. 15

17 <u>(b) For the year 2002 only, the director of revenue</u>
18 <u>shall assess all persons subject to assessment under</u>
19 subsection (a) of this section as follows:

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21 <u>(i) One-half (1/2) of the calendar year 2002</u>
22 <u>assessment determined on April 1, 2002 shall be paid on or</u>
23 before the first day of June 2002; and

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1 (ii) Of the remaining one-half (1/2) of the 2 calendar year 2002 assessment, only two-thirds (2/3) shall 3 be paid on or before the first day of October 2002. This 4 October payment shall serve as a transition to the dates in subsection (a) of this section. The remaining one-third 5 6 (1/3) shall not be paid. 7 8 Section 2. This act is effective April 1, 2002. 9
