A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to county officers; modifying the amount of
2 state payments to be made for the salary and expenses of
3 county and prosecuting attorneys and full-time assistants;
4 making an appropriation; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-107(f) is amended to read:

10

11 **18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;**
12 **additional compensation prohibited; exception as to**
13 **traveling and other expenses; compensation of county**
14 **commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,**
15 **stenographers and other assistants.**

1 (f) The state will pay ~~twenty thousand dollars~~
2 ~~(\$20,000.00) or~~ fifty percent (50%) of the salary of the
3 full-time county and prosecuting attorney, ~~whichever is~~
4 ~~less, per year,~~ to each qualifying county. In counties with
5 a population greater than nine thousand (9,000) the state
6 will pay ~~fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) or~~ fifty percent
7 (50%) of the salary of a full-time assistant to the county
8 and prosecuting attorney, ~~whichever is less, per year,~~ for
9 each assistant per ten thousand (10,000) population over
10 nine thousand (9,000). The state shall also pay ~~three~~
11 ~~thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)~~ five thousand dollars
12 (\$5,000.00) for expenses of the office of county and
13 prosecuting attorney for each full-time county and
14 prosecuting attorney and each full-time assistant
15 authorized by this act. Payments under this section shall
16 be made annually on or before June 30.

18 **Section 2.** Nine hundred ninety-four thousand six
19 hundred forty-seven dollars (\$994,647.00) or as much
20 thereof as is necessary is appropriated from the general
21 fund to the county and prosecuting attorney agency for
22 purposes of this act.
