A BILL

1	AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Food, Drug and Cosmetic
2	Safety Act; modifying proceedings for license revocations;
3	modifying reasons for license revocations; and providing
4	for an effective date.

6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
7	
8	Section 1. W.S. 35-7-126(a)(intro), by creating new
9	paragraphs (iv) through (vii) and (b) through (d) is
10	amended to read:
11	
12	35-7-126. License revocation.
13	
14	(a) Proceedings for <u>T</u>he <u>regulatory authority may</u>
15	<u>initiate</u> revocation of <u>proceedings</u> for an establishment
16	license: may be commenced by the filing of a written

1	application with the Wyoming board of agriculture or a
2	local board of health. The application shall be accompanied
3	by an affidavit of the director stating:
4	
5	(iv) For failure to correct conditions for which
6	a summary suspension was issued;
7	
8	(v) For failure to correct critical violations
9	from routine inspections;
10	
11	(vi) For multiple critical violations on
12	multiple occasions;
13	
14	(vii) For a refusal to grant access pursuant to
15	<u>W.S. 35-7-121.</u>
16	
17	(b) Upon receipt of the application, the state board
18	of agriculture or local board of health <u>The regulatory</u>
19	authority shall issue notice of a hearing to the license
20	holder. The notice and the hearing shall be governed by
21	the provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act,
22	W.S. 16-3-101 et seq.

1	(c) If, <u>U</u>pon completion of the hearing and
2	consideration of the record, the board finds that the
3	conditions present at the facility pose an imminent health
4	hazard the board regulatory authority shall issue an order
5	of license revocation which shall include findings of fact
6	and conclusions of law, and finding of actions necessary
7	to cure the causes leading to the revocation.
8	
9	(d) The decision of the board <u>regulatory</u> authority
10	may be appealed to the district court pursuant to the
11	Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, W.S. 16-3-101 et seq.
12	
13	Section 2. W.S. 35-7-126(a)(i) through (iii) is
14	repealed.
15	
16	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
