A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to water; requiring modifications to
- 2 irrigation facilities to be appropriately installed and
- 3 maintained; providing for recovery of costs in specified
- 4 circumstances; and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-5-111 is created to read:

9

- 10 41-5-111. Irrigation facility modification and
- 11 maintenance.

- 13 (a) An owner of property upon or through which an
- 14 irrigation facility is located who modifies an irrigation
- 15 ditch or any irrigation facility for the conveyance of
- 16 direct flow, storage water or waste water rights used by
- 17 authorized users shall be responsible for maintenance of

1 those unauthorized modifications. The modifications shall not diminish the capacities of the ditches and other 2 irrigation facilities. If the owner does not properly 3 4 maintain or otherwise ensure capacity and performance 5 through such modifications, users may, after forty-eight (48) hours written notice to the owner detailing the 6 problem and what maintenance, repairs or other work is 7 necessary, perform maintenance, repairs or other work 8 9 necessary to restore capacity and performance through the 10 area of such unauthorized modifications. The user 11 recover the cost of the reasonable maintenance modifications to restore flows from the owner who performed 12 13 the unauthorized modifications. The person or persons so 14 performing the maintenance or modifications may secure payment of the claim by filing an itemized and sworn 15 16 statement thereof, setting forth the date of the 17 performance and the nature of the labor so performed, with the county clerk of the county wherein the affected ditch 18 is situated, and when so filed, shall constitute a valid 19 20 lien against the interest of such person or persons who 21 failed to perform the work requisite to the proper 22 maintenance of the ditch, which lien when so taken may be enforced in the same manner as provided by law for the 23 24 enforcement of construction liens.

2 (b) For purposes of this section:

3

- 4 (i) "User" means a holder of a valid water right
- 5 such as an individual, ditch company, irrigation district
- 6 or other permitted use.

7

- 8 (ii) "Authorized modification" means any
- 9 modification which is required by the state engineer, water
- 10 division superintendent or his agent or any modification
- 11 which has been agreed to by an affected ditch company, or
- 12 if no ditch company exists, by the owner or owners of a
- 13 majority, by volume, of the water rights diverted through
- 14 the irrigation ditch or facility, provided no modification
- 15 shall harm or impede the delivery or use of any water right
- 16 or rights associated with those rights.

17

- 18 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
- 19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
- 20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
- 21 Constitution.
