- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1022 by creating a new subsection
- 9 (n) is amended to read:

- 11 9-2-1022. Duties of department performed through
- 12 human resources division.

- 14 (n) The state compensation plan shall provide that,
- 15 upon separation from state employment, a state employee or
- 16 the beneficiary of a deceased employee shall receive

1	payment, at the employee's rate of pay at separation, for
2	one-half (½) of the current balance of unused sick leave
3	not to exceed payment for four hundred eighty (480) hours,
4	subject to subsection (e) of this section. If the employee
5	is retiring from state employment and participating in the
6	state employees' and officials' group insurance plan, any
7	unused sick leave in excess of nine hundred sixty (960)
8	hours shall be treated as converted sick leave and shall be
9	reimbursed at the rate of one (1) month's contribution by
10	the state on behalf of the employee to the state employees'
11	and officials' group insurance plan for each sixteen (16)
12	hours of unused sick leave in excess of nine hundred sixty
13	(960) hours until the converted sick leave is exhausted or
14	the employee becomes eligible for Medicare under Title
15	XVIII of the federal Social Security Act, whichever first
16	occurs.

18	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
