A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT providing an appropriation for the alleviation of
- 2 specified conditions on the Wind River Indian Reservation
- 3 through education programs; imposing conditions upon the
- 4 expenditure of appropriated funds; and providing for an
- 5 effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

10

11 (a) The legislature finds that:

12

- 13 (i) Conditions of severe unemployment, poverty
- 14 and lack of adequate job skills exist on the Wind River
- 15 Indian Reservation;

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1	(ii)	Educational	programs	provided	bv	Shoshone

2 and Arapahoe Indian Tribes address these conditions on the

3 reservation;

4

5 (iii) The Shoshone and Arapahoe Indian Tribes

6 are sovereign nations whose members are also citizens of

7 the United States and residents of Wyoming;

8

9 (iv) With assistance from the state of Wyoming,

10 the Joint Tribal Council of the Shoshone and Arapahoe

11 Indian Tribes will be capable of continuing efforts to

12 address conditions existing on the reservation through the

13 provision of programs addressing the special educational

14 needs of Indian students. The maintenance of these special

15 educational programs unique to Indian students is of mutual

16 benefit to the tribes and to the state, reducing future

17 financial needs of those students as tribal members and as

18 Wyoming residents for public education, job services,

19 substance abuse services and income supplements.

20

21 (b) One hundred ninety-two thousand fifty-five

22 dollars (\$192,055.00) is appropriated from the general fund

23 to the governor. The governor shall enter into a contract

24 with the Joint Tribal Council of the Shoshone and Arapahoe

Indian Tribes whereby the funds appropriated under this 1

2 section shall be conveyed to the Joint Tribal Council to be

3 expended by the council for program enhancements, services

4 for students at-risk of failure in school and other

5 services essential to the success and welfare of students.

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7 (c) As part of the contract the Joint Tribal Council

shall agree to report to the governor and the joint 8

9 education interim committee on the expenditure of funds

10 under this section and on the impact of such expenditures

11 on student performance. The report shall be made not later

12 than June 30, 2004.

14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
