8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-23-301 is amended to read:

10 **22-23-301.** Municipal officers.

- 12 All candidates for municipal office shall be nominated at
- 13 the municipal primary election. In order to be eligible, a
- 14 candidate must be a registered voter and a resident of the
- 15 municipality and ward which he seeks to represent on the
- 16 day the petition is filed., and shall not be an employee of

1 the municipality No person successfully elected or

2 appointed may be sworn into office if he is an employee of

3 the municipality and is living in a city or town with a

4 population of two thousand (2,000) or more as determined by

the federal census as periodically updated by the bureau of 5

6 census.

Section 2. The common law rule of incompatibility of 8

9 office, to the extent specified in this act, is abrogated

in the context of municipal elections. 10

12 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 13

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 14

15 Constitution.
