Capitol building & supreme court repair.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the capitol building; providing 2 appropriations for certain repairs to the building as specified; providing for a study with an appropriation to 3 determine the feasibility of restoring the skylights in the 4 5 capitol building as specified; and providing for an effective date. 6 7 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 9 10 Section 1. 11 12 (a) To the extent funds are available under Section 2 13 of this act, the department of administration and 14 information shall complete the following specified work on 15 the capitol building:

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(i) Up to one million six hundred fifty thousand 1 2 dollars (\$1,650,000.00) for removal and replacement of the 3 existing heating system with a new hot water/closed loop 4 system; 5 6 (ii) Up to three million four hundred thousand 7 dollars (\$3,400,000.00) for replacement of the fan coil units and upgrading the ventilation system; 8 9 10 (iii) Up to seven hundred fifty-three thousand 11 dollars (\$753,000.00) for installation of a fire protection 12 system; 13 (iv) Up to four hundred fifty-seven thousand 14 dollars (\$457,000.00) for installation of a fire alarm 15 16 system; and 17 18 (v) Up to one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) for replacement and repair of the 19 20 electrical system. 21 Section 2. 22 23

The state building commission shall conduct a 1 (a) study on the feasibility of restoring the skylights in the 2 3 house chamber, senate chamber and the capitol rotunda in 4 the capitol building so that the roof of the capitol will 5 allow natural light to filter through the skylights. The commission may contract with appropriate expertise 6 and 7 professionals as necessary to perform the study. The commission shall report its findings to the management 8 9 council and the select committee on legislative facilities 10 on or before November 1, 2003. 11 12 (b) There is appropriated ten thousand dollars 13 (\$10,000.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from the 14 budget reserve account to the state building commission to implement the purposes of this section. 15 16 17 Section 3. 18 19 The following amounts are appropriated to the (a) 20 department of administration and information for purposes 21 of section 1 of this act: 22 23 (i) One million three hundred ten thousand dollars (\$1,310,000.00) from the budget reserve account; 24

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2 (ii) Notwithstanding 2001 Wyoming Session Laws, 3 Chapter 139, Section 4 which created Section 336, any 4 unobligated and unexpended funds available on the effective 5 date of this act from appropriations for the design and construction of the multi-level parking structure for the 6 state capitol office complex, not to exceed one million 7 three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000.00); 8

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10 (iii) Notwithstanding any other provision of 11 law, any unobligated and unexpended funds available on the 12 effective date of this act from appropriations to the 13 general services division of the department of administration and information for capital construction 14 projects, deferred or critical maintenance 15 and 16 contingencies, not to exceed one million three hundred 17 thousand dollars (\$1,300,000.00);

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(iv) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 19 20 not to exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) of the 21 amounts made available under Section 325 of the 2003 22 Supplemental Budget for major maintenance needs of the 23 state;

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1 (v) During the 1994 legislative session, the 2 legislature appropriated funds for capital construction 3 projects and authorized that those projects could be 4 financed under W.S. 9-4-605 through the issuance of revenue 5 bonds. Interest has accumulated in excess of the amounts necessary to fund the projects in an amount of one million 6 7 five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00). There is appropriated from this excess interest one million five 8 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) from this account 9 10 for the purposes of this act; 11 12 hundred fifty thousand dollars (vi) One 13 (\$150,000.00) from the public buildings at the capitol permanent land fund created under W.S. 9-4-310(a)(ii). 14 15 (b) The following shall apply to subsection (a) of 16 this section: 17 18 19 1996 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 1, (i) 20 Section 305(c) is repealed; 21 22 (ii) 1986 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 81, Section 4 is repealed; 23 24

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1	(iii) W.S. 1-42-104(a) is repealed;
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3	(iv) Of the funds de-appropriated under this
4	subsection, one million two hundred thousand dollars
5	(\$1,200,000.00) is appropriated for the purposes of this
6	act.
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8	Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon
9	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
10	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
11	Constitution.
