5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-405 by creating a new subsection
- 8 (b) is amended to read:

10 9-3-405. Retirement board duties and powers.

- 12 (b) The board may establish special pay plans
- 13 that upon retirement or separation from service, entitle an
- 14 employee of the state to a contribution to a qualified
- 15 retirement plan established in the employee's name.
- 16 Special pay plans established under this paragraph shall be

1	in compliance with section 401(a) of the federal Internal
2	Revenue Code, which reduce the federal tax burden on
3	accumulated vacation, sick or other accumulated leave
4	payments to employees upon retirement or separation from
5	service. In the event an employee elects to withdraw his
6	contribution to the special pay plan prior to reaching age
7	fifty-five (55), the state shall reimburse the employee the
8	difference between any Federal Insurance Contributions Act
9	(FICA) and any Medicare tax savings to the employee and any
10	early withdrawal penalty imposed by the Internal Revenue
11	Service.

13	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
14	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
