A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to cruelty to animals; providing for a
- 2 felony offense if cruelty results in the death of an animal
- 3 as specified; prescribing a penalty; making conforming
- 4 amendments; and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-203(a)(intro), (i), (ii), (e),
- 9 (h), (j)(intro), (m)(intro) and by creating a new
- 10 subsection (n) is amended to read:

11

- 12 6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation on
- 13 manner of destruction.

14

1 (a) A person commits cruelty to animals if he

2 knowingly and with intent to cause death, injury or undue

3 suffering:

4

- 5 (i) Overrides, an animal or drives an animal
- when overloaded; tortures or torments an animal or 6
- 7 deprives an animal of necessary sustenance; or

8

- (ii) Unnecessarily or cruelly beats, tortures, 9
- torments, injures, or mutilates or kills an animal; or 10

11

- 12 (e) Cruelty to animals Unless punishable under
- 13 subsection (n) of this section, a violation of this section
- is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more 14
- than six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred 15
- fifty dollars (\$750.00), or both except that a subsequent 16
- 17 offense, or aggravated cruelty to animals as defined by
- paragraphs subsection (c)(ii), (iv), (v) and (vi) of this 18
- 19 section is a high misdemeanor punishable by not more than
- 20 one (1) year imprisonment, a fine of not more than five
- 21 thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

- 23 (h) If a person convicted of cruelty to animals under
- 24 a violation of this section is also the owner of the

- 1 animal, the court may require the person to forfeit
- 2 ownership of the animal to the county in which the person
- 3 is convicted. This subsection shall not affect the
- 4 interest of any secured party or other person who has not
- 5 participated in the offense.

- (j) In addition to any sentence and penalties imposed 7
- under subsections (e), and (h) and (n) of this section, the 8
- 9 court may:

- (m) Nothing in subsection (a), or (b) or (n) of this 11
- section shall be construed to prohibit: 12

- 14 (n) A person commits a felony if he knowingly and
- 15 with intent to cause death, injury or undue suffering,
- cruelly beats, tortures, torments, injures or mutilates an 16
- 17 animal resulting in the death or required euthanasia of the
- animal. A felony under this subsection is punishable by not 18
- 19 more than two (2) years imprisonment, a fine of not more

20 than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

22 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
