## ENROLLED ACT NO. 7, SENATE

## FIFTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING 2003 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Food, Drug and Cosmetic Safety Act; modifying proceedings for license revocations; modifying reasons for license revocations; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 35-7-126(a)(intro), by creating new paragraphs (iv) through (vii) and (b) through (d) is amended to read:

## 35-7-126. License revocation.

(a) <u>Proceedings for The regulatory authority may</u> <u>initiate</u> revocation <u>of proceedings for</u> an establishment license: <u>may be commenced by the filing of a written</u> <u>application with the Wyoming board of agriculture or a</u> <u>local board of health. The application shall be accompanied</u> <u>by an affidavit of the director stating:</u>

(iv) For failure to correct conditions for which a summary suspension was issued;

(v) For failure to correct critical violations from routine inspections;

(vi) For multiple critical violations on multiple occasions;

(vii) For a refusal to grant access pursuant to W.S. 35-7-121.

(b) Upon receipt of the application, the state board of agriculture or local board of health The regulatory authority shall issue notice of a hearing to the license ORIGINAL SENATE FILE NO. 0007

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holder. The notice and the hearing shall be governed by the provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, W.S. 16-3-101 et seq.

(c) If, Upon completion of the hearing and consideration of the record, the board finds that the conditions present at the facility pose an imminent health hazard the board regulatory authority shall issue an order of license revocation which shall include findings of fact and conclusions of law., and finding of actions necessary to cure the causes leading to the revocation.

(d) The decision of the <u>board</u> <u>regulatory authority</u> may be appealed to the district court pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, W.S. 16-3-101 et seq.

Section 2. W.S. 35-7-126(a)(i) through (iii) is repealed.

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Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
