AN ACT relating to small employer health insurance availability; modifying index rate variations within a business class as specified; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 26-19-304(a)(ii) is amended to read:

26-19-304. Restrictions relating to premium rates.

- (a) Premium rates for health benefit plans subject to this act shall be subject to the following provisions:
- (ii) For a class of business, the premium rates charged during a rating period to small employers with similar case characteristics for the same or similar coverage, or the rates which could be charged to such employers under the rating system for that class of business shall not vary from the index rate by more than twenty-five percent (25%) thirty-five (35%) of the index rate;
