for

AN ACT relating to law enforcement retirement; authorizing 1 2 specified employees at state parks and historic sites to 3 participate in the law enforcement retirement system; 4 amending a definition; conditioning implementation upon receipt of required payments and transfer of covered 5 employees as specified; providing an appropriation; and 6 providing for an effective date. 7

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

11 Section 1. W.S. 9-3-402(a) (xviii) is amended to read:

13 9-3-402. Definitions.

(a) As used in this article: 15

2 (xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" 3 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county 4 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized 5 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), 6 any 7 superintendent, assistant superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park or historic site meeting the 8 9 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(G), investigator employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 10 11 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 12 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, Wyoming 13 law enforcement academy instructor, University of Wyoming campus police officer, detention officer or dispatcher for 14 law enforcement agencies; 15

19 (a) Coverage of superintendents, assistant
20 superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or
21 historic sites under W.S. 9-3-432 as provided by section 1
22 of this act shall not be implemented by the Wyoming
23 retirement board until funds payable to the Wyoming
24 retirement system are received for deposit into the

1 retirement account, as necessary for maintaining the

2 actuarial integrity of the account and funding all

3 liability arising under this act, for years of service

4 prior to the date of entry or expansion of coverage.

5

6 (b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section,

7 W.S. 9-3-432, with respect to superintendents, assistant

8 superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or

9 historic sites, shall not be implemented by the Wyoming

10 retirement board until funds necessary for maintaining the

11 actuarial integrity of the account and funding any

12 liability arising under this act, are deposited into the

13 Wyoming retirement account by the Wyoming department of

14 state parks and cultural resources, and contributions

15 required under W.S. 9-3-432(a) and (b) are paid to the

16 Wyoming retirement system for deposit into the retirement

17 account for at least two (2) months of covered service

18 following the date of entry of coverage, as applicable.

20 **Section 3.** There is appropriated three hundred fifty

21 thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) from the general fund to the

22 department of state parks and cultural resources to be

23 deposited in the retirement account as required by section

24 2 of this act to fund the liability arising under this act

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1 for the coverage of superintendents, assistant

2 superintendents and full-time park rangers of state parks

3 or historic sites as provided in section 1 of this act.

5 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
