6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-11-312 is created to read:

9

10 **35-11-312.** Fees.

11

- 12 (a) The department shall implement a surface water
- 13 point source discharge permit fee system. On July 1 of
- 14 each year, the department shall assess an annual permit fee
- 15 of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each active surface
- 16 water point source discharge permit and for each permit

1 authorization held by any person under W.S. 35-11-301

2 during any portion of the preceding twelve (12) month

3 period. The department shall prepare a biennium report on

4 the fee system for review by the joint minerals, business

5 and economic development interim committee by October 31 of

6 the year prior to the Wyoming legislative budget session.

7

8 (b) The fees collected by the department pursuant to

9 this section shall be deposited in a separate account

10 within the earmarked revenue fund, and shall be subject to

11 appropriation by the legislature to the department to be

12 used for costs associated with:

13

14 (i) Surface water quality monitoring and

15 analysis;

16

17 (ii) Surface water quality modeling analysis and

18 demonstrations;

19

20 (iii) Other nonoperating costs associated with

21 surface water discharges.

22

(c) The revenue generated by this section shall not 1

be used for operational costs associated with permit 2

3 processing.

4

5 (d) The department may reduce any fee required under

this section to take into account the financial resources 6

7 of small businesses as defined by the United States Small

Business Administration. 8

10 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 11

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 12

Constitution. 13
