4 (a) The veteran burial team account is created within 5 the earmarked revenue fund. Subject to rules and regulations policies and procedures adopted by the 6 veterans' commission, Wyoming veteran burial teams who have 7 contracted with the commission may apply for reimbursement 8 9 of any actual and necessary expenses incurred in payment 10 for the performance of military funeral duties not to 11 exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per funeral. The 12 commission shall also maintain a list of registered veteran 13 burial teams and provide that list upon request.

14

(b) Any claim made pursuant to this section shall be 15 made to the veterans' commission. The commission shall 16 17 review and act upon all claims submitted under subsection (a) of this section no later than June 30 following the 18 19 calendar year in which expenses were incurred for the claim 20 submitted. If after deducting and paying the commission's 21 administrative expenses in processing claims there are 22 insufficient funds within the veteran burial team account to pay all approved claims, the commission shall prorate 23 24 reimbursement among all approved claims. Payments

1 authorized through the commission pursuant to this section

shall be paid by the state treasurer by warrant issued by 2

3 the state auditor upon vouchers signed by the state

4 veterans' service officer or his designee.

(c) As used in this section, "veteran burial team" 6

means any group of veterans that the commission has 7

contracted with, pursuant to rules and regulations policies 8

9 and procedures, to perform military services within the

10 state of Wyoming authorized by the commission during the

11 burial of any decedent who has received any military

12 discharge, other than a dishonorable discharge, from the

armed forces of the United States. 13

17 (a) The policies and procedures adopted by the

veterans' commission pursuant to this act shall not be 18

subject to provisions of the Wyoming Administrative 19

20 Procedure Act.

22 (b) The provisions of this act shall apply to claims

payable under W.S. 19-14-109 for services rendered on or 23

after July 1, 2003. 24

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 2

3 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 4

5 Constitution.
