1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; applying the protections of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act 2 3 of 1940, as amended, to national guard members as specified; providing a penalty; specifying how the 4 5 protections may be used; specifying jurisdiction; providing definitions; making conforming amendments; and providing 6 7 for an effective date. 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 9 10 Section 1. W.S. 19-11-122 by creating new subsections 11 (a) and (b) and by amending and renumbering (a) and (b) as 12 (c) and (d) is amended to read: 13 14 19-11-122. Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 15 16 1940, as amended; application to national guard; penalty

for violation of rights afforded to guard members;
enforcement; preferences.

4 (a) Members of the Wyoming national guard ordered to 5 active state service by the state or federal government for a period of more than thirty (30) consecutive days shall 6 7 have all protections afforded to persons in the military 8 service of the United States under the Soldiers' and 9 Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended (54 Stat. 1178, 50 App. U.S.C. 501 et seq.). Except as provided in 10 subsection (b) of this section, nothing in this subsection 11 12 shall be construed to authorize the imposition of any 13 penalty under the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act 14 of 1940, as amended, for violation of the protections afforded to members of the Wyoming national guard pursuant 15 16 to this subsection. As used in this subsection, "active 17 state service" means as defined in W.S. 19-7-101(a)(v).

19 (b) Any person who knowingly violates the protections 20 provided to members of the Wyoming national guard pursuant 21 to subsection (a) of this section shall be guilty of a 22 misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand 23 dollars (\$1,000.00).

1	(a) (c) The protections afforded to members of the
2	Wyoming national guard pursuant to subsection (a) of this
3	section may serve as the basis for an action or as a
4	defense. The district courts of this state that would
5	otherwise have jurisdiction over a case shall have
6	jurisdiction over proceedings involving the Soldiers' and
7	Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended, and the
8	Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act,
9	which shall be governed by the rules applicable to ordinary
10	proceedings.

(b) (d) The district and appellate courts shall give preference in scheduling such proceedings, upon the motion of any person in the uniformed services, or the person's attorney, who presents certification that the person has performed service in the uniformed services or is in service in the uniformed services.

19 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 20 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 21 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 22 Constitution.
