(a) The department may expend state funds for the purchase of: (i) Civil air patrol aviation education training aids; (ii) Books and equipment; (iii) Maintenance and hangar rents of "on-loan" United States air force aircraft; and (iv) Maintenance supplies and equipment for a communications network for the civil air patrol. 19-15-102. Approval of purchase order. No expenditure of state funds shall be made unless a purchase order is approved by the department. Funds are under the control of the department. 19-15-103. Limitation of expenditures.

(a) Under W.S. 19-15-101 through 19-15-103 1 no 2 expenditure of state funds shall be authorized by the 3 department unless the purchase is specifically for: 4 5 (i) Civil air patrol aviation education training aids, books and equipment; 6 7 (ii) Maintenance and hangar rent of "on-loan" 8 9 United States air force aircraft of two hundred fifty (250) 10 horsepower or less; and 11 12 (iii) Maintenance supplies and equipment for 13 civil air patrol communications network and administrative costs as may be approved by the department. 14 15 16 Section 2. W.S. 10-3-501 through 10-3-503 are 17 repealed. 18 19 Section 3. All supplies and equipment of the civil 20 air patrol owned by the state of Wyoming shall be 21 transferred to the military department. 22 This act is effective immediately upon 23 Section 4. 24 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
