Permits for and certain highways to carry, 12 overweight and oversize vehicles; government vehicles. 13 14 (a) The director or his authorized representative may issue permits for separate movements or extended periods of 15 16 movement effective for one (1) or more months, not to exceed ninety (90) days permitting hauling of forest 17

No permit issued 2 under this section shall be granted for any load of forest 3 products exceeding one hundred twelve (112) inches in width 4 or any load of baled hay or combine headers exceeding one 5 hundred fifty (150) inches in width and fifteen (15) feet in height. No single component of the load may exceed one 6 7 hundred two (102) inches in width. The fee for a single trip permit is fifteen dollars (\$15.00). The fee for an 8 9 extended period permit is fifty dollars (\$50.00). During a 10 drought as declared by the governor for purposes of this 11 subsection, the director or his designated representative 12 shall issue, without fee, a single trip or extended period 13 permit under this subsection to any out-of-state truck 14 delivering hay to a drought area within this state.

16 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 19 Constitution.
