## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to gasoline tax distribution; modifying the
- 2 gasoline tax distribution formulas for snowmobile and
- 3 motorboat use; removing the sunset on motorboat gasoline
- 4 tax distribution formula; creating a gasoline tax
- 5 distribution formula for off-road recreational vehicles;
- 6 specifying use of the new distribution; and providing for
- 7 an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-17-111(c)(ii), (iii) and by
- 12 creating a new paragraph (iv) is amended to read:

14 **39-17-111.** Distribution.

15

1 (c) The department shall certify to the state

2 treasurer amounts to be credited to appropriate accounts

3 based upon deductions from the taxes collected under this

4 article in the following order:

6 (ii) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in

7 snowmobiles, computed by multiplying the number of

8 snowmobiles for which registration and user fees have been

9 paid during the current fiscal year under W.S.

10 31-2-404(a)(i) and 31-2-409(a)(ii) times sixteen dollars

11 and twenty-five cents (\$16.25) the tax imposed by W.S.

12 39-17-104(a) on two hundred twenty-five (225) gallons of

13 gasoline, plus the number of snowmobiles for which

14 registration fees have been paid during the current fiscal

15 year under W.S. 31-2-404(a)(ii) times thirty-two dollars

16 and fifty cents (\$32.50) the tax imposed by W.S.

17 <u>39-17-104(a)</u> on one thousand two hundred eighty (1,280)

18 gallons of gasoline. The amount computed shall be credited

19 to an account within the earmarked revenue fund to be

20 expended by the department of state parks and cultural

21 resources to improve snowmobile trails in Wyoming;

23 (iii) Until June 30, 2003, Deduct an amount

24 collected on fuel used in motorboats, computed by

2 current fiscal year under W.S. 41-13-102 and five thousand

3 (5,000) nonresident motorboats times sixteen dollars and

4 twenty-five cents (\$16.25) the tax imposed by W.S.

5 39-17-104(a) on one hundred twenty-five (125) gallons of

6 gasoline. The amount computed shall be credited to an

7 account within the earmarked revenue fund to be expended by

8 the department of state parks and cultural resources to

9 improve facilities for use by motorboats and motorboat

10 users at state parks and state recreation areas and to

11 provide grants to governmental entities for improvement of

12 publicly owned boating facilities at public parks and

13 recreational facilities;

14

15 (iv) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in

16 off-road recreational vehicles, computed by multiplying the

17 number of off-road recreational vehicles for which user

18 registration fees have been paid during the current fiscal

19 year under W.S. 31-2-703(a) times the tax imposed by W.S.

20 39-17-104(a) on one hundred twenty-five (125) gallons of

21 gasoline. The amount computed shall be credited to an

22 <u>account within the earmarked revenue fund to be expended by</u>

23 the department of state parks and cultural resources to

24 improve off-road recreational vehicle trails in Wyoming.

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2 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
