## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to water; requiring modifications to
- 2 irrigation facilities to be appropriately installed and
- 3 maintained; providing for recovery of costs in specified
- 4 circumstances; and providing for an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-5-111 is created to read:

9

- 10 41-5-111. Irrigation facility modification and
- 11 maintenance.

- 13 (a) An owner who modifies an irrigation ditch or any
- 14 irrigation facility for the conveyance of direct flow
- 15 rights used by authorized downstream users shall be
- 16 responsible for maintenance of those modified facilities.
- 17 The modifications shall not diminish the capacities of the

1 ditches and other irrigation facilities. If the owner does 2 not properly maintain or otherwise ensure performance, users may, after ten (10) days written notice 3 4 to the owner detailing the problem and what maintenance or 5 modification is necessary, perform reasonable maintenance 6 modifications necessary to restore direct flow 7 performance. The user may recover the cost of the reasonable maintenance and modifications to restore flows 8 9 from the owner who performed the modifications. The person 10 or persons so performing the maintenance or modifications may secure payment of the claim by filing an itemized and 11 12 sworn statement thereof, setting forth the date of the 13 performance and the nature of the labor so performed, with 14 the county clerk of the county wherein the affected ditch is situated, and when so filed, shall constitute a valid 15 16 lien against the interest of such person or persons who 17 failed to perform the work requisite to the proper maintenance of said ditch, which said lien when so taken 18 may be enforced in the same manner as provided by law for 19 20 the enforcement of construction liens.

22 (b) For purposes of this section:

23

(i) "Owner" means property owner or owner of any

permanent water right;

(ii) "User" means a downstream water right
holder, authorized irrigator or ditch company.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
