A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; providing that a vacancy  
2 occurs if a member of the state legislature fails to reside  
3 in his district; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-18-101 by creating a new  
8 subsection (f) is amended to read:

10 **22-18-101. When deemed to occur.**

12 (f) In addition to subsections (a) through (c) of  
13 this section, a vacancy shall occur in the office of a  
14 member of the state legislature when the person fails to  
15 reside in the legislative district from which he is  
16 elected, provided that no vacancy occurs for the current

1 term of office of a senator who no longer resides in his  
2 legislative district as a result of reapportionment.

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2003.
