8	Section 1. W.S. 9-3-602(a)(xiii) and 9-3-611(a), (b)
9	and (d) are amended to read:

11	9-3-602. Definitions.

13	(a) As used in this article:
14	
15	(xiii) " Total <u>D</u>isability" means a medically
16	determined physical or mental impairment which renders the

1 employee totally unable to work function in any the 2 occupation for which he is reasonably suited by training or 3 experience trained or experienced and which is reasonably 4 expected to last at least twelve (12) months;

9 (a) Any employee who suffers a partial or total disability resulting from an individual and specific act, 10 11 the type of which would normally occur only while employed 12 as an employee, is eligible for a duty-connected disability 13 allowance. If the specific act involves a traumatic event which directly causes an immediate cardiovascular condition 14 resulting in partial or total a disability, the employee is 15 16 eligible for a partial or total duty-connected disability allowance. 17

(b) Any employee with ten (10) years of credited service who suffers a partial or total disability and who is not eligible for a duty-connected disability allowance is eligible for an ordinary partial or total disability allowance.

2	shall be as follows:

4	(i) <u>an amount equal to f</u>ifty percent (50%) of
5	the highest average salary. for duty-connected or ordinary
6	total disability;

8	(ii) Thirty-five percent (35%) of highest
9	average salary for duty-connected partial disability; and

11	(iii) Twenty-five percent (25%) of highest
12	average salary for ordinary partial disability.
