6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-8-501 by creating a new subsection
- 9 (b) is amended to read:

11 36-8-501. Powers generally.

- 13 (b) The board of land commissioners is hereby
- 14 authorized and empowered to purchase in the name of the
- 15 state of Wyoming and to pay an amount not to exceed three
- 16 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000.00) less

1 costs of appraisal or one hundred ten percent (110%) of the

- 2 appraised value, whichever is less, for the following lands
- 3 in Fremont county containing approximately 216.46 acres
- 4 which are hereby declared to be part of the Old South Pass
- 5 Historical Preserve-Wyoming:

- 7 (i) In township 29 north, range 100 west, 6th
- 8 p.m., SE1/4 SE1/4 NE1/4, NE1/4 NE1/4 SE1/4 of section 20;
- 9 W1/2 SW1/4 NW1/4 of section 21; E1/2 SW1/4 NW1/4 of section
- 10 21; and W1/4 SE1/4 NW1/4 of section 21.

- 12 **Section 2.** The department of environmental quality
- 13 shall investigate the potential use of monies from the
- 14 abandoned mine land fund to restore the Carissa gold mine
- 15 property to acceptable levels of public safety. The
- 16 department shall report its findings including the costs of
- 17 restoration and any recommendations to the board of land
- 18 commissioners, joint travel, recreation, wildlife and
- 19 cultural resources interim committee and the Wyoming parks
- 20 and cultural resources commission not later than December
- 21 1, 2003. If the board of land commissioners concludes the
- 22 cost of restoration to be unreasonable in its sound
- 23 discretion, the board may consider the resale of the
- 24 property.

2 **Section 3.** There is appropriated from the general

3 fund three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars

4 (\$325,000.00) to the board of land commissioners for the

5 purposes of this act.

7 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
