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7	Section 1. W.S. 31-2-204(b) is amended to read:

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1 number assigned to the vehicle, set forth in embossed 2 numerals and letters as determined by the department and above or underneath such numerals shall be the embossed 3 4 word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the year of issue or 5 validation. The design on the license plate shall be 6 determined by the department of transportation in 7 conjunction with the council on the arts. License plates dealers and for trailers shall 8 issued to contain 9 appropriate identification which may be in lieu of the 10 bucking horse and rider emblem. License plates shall be 11 changed or validated annually. There shall be a marked 12 contrast between the color of the plate and that of the 13 numerals and letters and the background of all plates shall 14 be fully reflectorized. Motorcycle plates shall not be less than three (3) inches wide and six (6) inches long. Antique 15 16 license plates shall bear no date and shall bear the 17 inscription "Pioneer Wyo". License stickers for trucks and 18 trailers used by any farmer or rancher for the 19 transportation of livestock, feed or unprocessed 20 agricultural products owned and produced by the farmer or 21 rancher from the place of production to market and of ranch 22 supplies intended solely for the use of the farmer or 23 rancher, and not for sale, on the return trip, and not for 24 the transportation of goods and persons for hire shall bear

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1 the inscription "Farm". Upon application to the department 2 and payment of a fee as provided by W.S. 31-3-102(a)(xix), 3 veteran license stickers bearing the inscription "Veteran" 4 and designating the conflict service of the veteran may be 5 issued to the veterans' affairs commission in a format department. The veterans' 6 approved by the affairs 7 commission may sell the veteran license sticker to qualified veterans at a fee not to exceed cost, plus ten 8 9 dollars (\$10.00) per vehicle. Any fees collected by the veterans' affairs commission under this subsection shall be 10 11 deposited in the veterans' affairs commission expendable 12 The veterans' affairs commission trust fund. shall 13 establish eligibility criteria for veterans applying for a 14 veteran license sticker. A qualified veteran purchasing a 15 veteran license sticker manufactured by the department and sold by the veterans' affairs commission may display the 16 17 sticker on the license plate issued by the county treasurer. The provisions of W.S. 31-2-205(a)(iv) shall not 18 apply to any veteran license sticker manufactured by the 19 20 department and displayed as provided in this section. 21

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003.
