- 14 The department, in consultation with the correctional
- 15 industries advisory board, may establish programs for the
- 16 employment of inmates by private employers and enter into

1 agreements with private employers under which the employer 2 owns, constructs, leases to or from the department or 3 otherwise establishes facilities within the exterior boundaries of any state correctional facility to 4 5 manufacture or process goods or conduct any other business, commercial or agricultural enterprise and employ inmates at 6 the from a correctional facility. Facilities established 7 under this section may be located within or outside the 8 9 exterior boundaries of a state correctional facility 10 property. Construction of all facilities by private employers under this section shall not be competitively 11 12 subject to competitive bid and performed under W.S. 13 27-4-401 through 27-4-413 requirements applicable to 14 construction by the state. Inmate labor may be used pursuant to W.S. 7-16-202 for construction of facilities 15 that occurs within the exterior boundaries of a state 16 17 correctional facility property under this section. 18 19 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003. 20
