- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-3-203(a)(intro), (i), (ii), (e) and
- 9 (h) is amended to read:

- 11 6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation on

- 14 (a) A person commits cruelty to animals if he
- 15 knowingly and with intent to cause death, injury or undue
- 16 suffering:

2 (i) Overrides, an animal or drives an animal when overloaded;, tortures or torments an animal or 3 4 deprives an animal of necessary sustenance; or 5 (ii) Unnecessarily or cruelly beats, tortures, 6 7 torments, injures, or mutilates or kills an animal; or 8 9 (e) Cruelty to animals A violation of this section is 10 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty 11 12 dollars (\$750.00), or both except that: 13 (i) A subsequent offense, or aggravated cruelty 14 to animals as defined by paragraphs subsection (c) (ii), 15 16 (iv), (v) and (vi) of this section is a high misdemeanor 17 punishable by not more than one (1) year imprisonment, a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or 18 19 both; -20 21 (ii) A violation of paragraph (a)(ii) of this 22 section which results in the death of the animal is a

felony punishable by not more than five (5) years

1 imprisonment, a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars 2 (\$10,000.00), or both. 3 (h) If a person convicted of cruelty to animals under 4 5 a violation of this section is also the owner of the animal, the court may require the person to forfeit 6 7 ownership of the animal to the county in which the person is convicted. This subsection shall not affect the 8 9 interest of any secured party or other person who has not 10 participated in the offense. 11 12 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2003. 13 14 (END)
