- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
- 5 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
- 6 separately, concurring therein:

- 8 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 9 Constitution, Article 15, Section 17 is proposed for
- 10 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
- 11 next general election for approval or rejection to become
- 12 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
- 13 majority of the electors at the election:

- 15 Article 15, Section 17. County levy for support and
- 16 maintenance of public schools.

2 There shall be levied each year in each county of the state 3 a tax of not to exceed six (6) mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of the property in each county for the 4 5 support and maintenance of the public schools. This tax shall be collected by the county treasurer and disbursed 6 among the school districts within the county as the 7 8 legislature shall provide. The legislature may authorize 9 boards of trustees of school districts to levy a special tax on the property of the district. The legislature may 10 11 also provide for the distribution among one (1) or more school districts of not more than three-fourths of any 12 13 revenue from the special school district property tax. in 14 excess of a state average yield, which shall be calculated

17 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse

the following statement on the proposed amendment:

each year, per average daily membership.

The adoption of this amendment eliminates a maximum on the amount of revenues rebated from school districts with assessed valuations exceeding statewide averages.
