4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 5 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 6 separately, concurring therein:

8 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming 9 Constitution, Article 7, Section 1 is proposed for 10 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the 11 next general election for approval or rejection to become 12 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a 13 majority of the electors at the election:

Article 7, Section 1. Legislature to provide for public schools; provision for necessary small schools.

1	(a) The legislature shall provide for the
2	establishment and maintenance of a complete and uniform
3	system of public instruction, embracing free elementary
4	schools of every needed kind and grade, a university with
5	such technical and professional departments as the public
6	good may require and the means of the state allow, and such
7	other institutions as may be necessary.
8	
9	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section or
10	any other provision of this constitution, the legislature

11 <u>may as it deems appropriate, define by law and fund</u>
12 <u>necessary small public schools. Such funding shall not be</u>
13 <u>subject to nor considered in any uniformity requirement for</u>
14 <u>the system of public instruction.</u>

Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
the following statement on the proposed amendment:

1 The adoption of this amendment authorizes the legislature 2 to provide for necessary small public schools as it 3 determines appropriate including the establishment of such 4 funding levels and grade configurations as the legislature 5 deems necessary and appropriate for small schools.
