1	AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; applying the
2	protections of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act to
3	national guard members as specified; providing a penalty;
4	specifying how the protections may be used; specifying
5	jurisdiction; providing definitions; making conforming
6	amendments; and providing for an effective date.

8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10	Section 1. W.S. 19-11-102(c) and 19-11-122 are
11	amended to read:

13	19-11-102. Purpose.
14	
15	(c) The provisions of this article are intended to be
16	supplemental to any rights that persons called to military

1	service have under any applicable federal statutes,
2	including the Soldiers' and Sailors' <u>Servicemembers</u> Civil
3	Relief Act of 1940, as amended, 50 U.S.C. 501 et seq.
4	Public Law 108-189, the Uniformed Services Employment and
5	Reemployment Rights Act, 43 U.S.C. 4301 et seq., and under
6	any other applicable laws of this state.
7	
8	19-11-122. Servicemembers Civil Relief Act;
9	application to national guard; penalty for violation of
10	rights afforded to guard members; enforcement; preferences.
11	
12	(a) Members of the Wyoming national guard ordered to
13	active state service by the state or federal government for
14	a period of more than thirty (30) consecutive days shall
15	have all protections afforded to persons in the military
16	service of the United States under the Servicemembers Civil
17	Relief Act, Public Law 108-189. Except as provided in
18	subsection (b) of this section, nothing in this subsection
19	shall be construed to authorize the imposition of any
20	penalty under the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act for
21	violation of the protections afforded to members of the
22	Wyoming national guard pursuant to this subsection. As
23	used in this subsection, "active state service" means as

2	(b) Any person who knowingly violates the protections
3	provided to members of the Wyoming national guard pursuant
4	to subsection (a) of this section shall be guilty of a
5	misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand
6	<u>dollars (\$1,000.00).</u>
7	
8	(a) (c) The protections afforded to members of the
9	Wyoming national guard pursuant to subsection (a) of this
10	section may serve as the basis for an action or as a
11	defense. The district courts of this state that would
12	otherwise have jurisdiction over a case shall have
13	jurisdiction over proceedings involving the Soldiers' and
14	Sailors' Servicemembers Civil Relief Act of 1940, as
15	amended, and the Uniformed Services Employment and
16	Reemployment Rights Act, which shall be governed by the
17	rules applicable to ordinary proceedings.
18	

19 (b) (d) The district and appellate courts shall give 20 preference in scheduling such proceedings, upon the motion 21 of any person in the uniformed services, or the person's attorney, who presents certification that the person has 22 performed service in the uniformed services or is in 23 service in the uniformed services. 24
