## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to private school licensing; clarifying
- 2 exemptions from licensing requirements for religious
- 3 schools as specified; imposing additional requirements upon
- 4 certain post secondary religious schools for receiving and
- 5 maintaining exemption status; and providing for an
- 6 effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-406 and 21-4-101(a)(iv) are
- 11 amended to read:

- 21-2-406. Schools exempted; additional requirements
- 14 for specified post secondary religious schools.

16 (a) This article does not apply to:

2	(i) Any parochial, church or religious school as
3	defined by W.S. 21-4-101(a)(iv), or institution owned,
4	controlled, operated or maintained by a bona fide church,
5	religious denomination or religious organization comprised
6	of multidenominational members of the same recognized
7	religion, lawfully operating the school or institution
8	pursuant to applicable laws governing its organization, and
9	the school or institution:
10	
11	(A) Offers elementary and secondary
12	education programs only; or
13	
14	(B) Operates only as a post secondary
15	education degree granting institution if post secondary
16	education programs are limited to instruction in the
17	principles of that church, religious denomination or
18	religious organization and the diploma or degree is limited
19	to evidence of completion of these post secondary education
20	programs, subject to the following:
21	
22	(I) A disclosure is made by the
23	institution on all documents submitted to potential and
24	enrolled students and on all institutional marketing

1	materials which clearly states the institution claims an
2	exemption under this article, that the institution is not
3	accredited by an accreditation association recognized by
4	the United States department of education and is not
5	licensed as a private school by this state;
6	
7	(II) Diplomas or degrees issued by the
8	institution are restricted to the beliefs and practices of
9	the affiliated church, religious denomination or religious
10	organization and include a statement on the face of the
11	diploma or degree referencing the theological or religious
12	nature of the subject area for which the diploma or degree
13	is awarded, clearly reflecting the nature of the degree
14	title as "Associate of Religious Studies", "Bachelor of
15	Religious Studies", "Master of Divinity" or "Doctor of
16	Divinity"; and
17	
18	(III) Evidence of nonprofit religious
19	organization status for purposes of federal taxation and
20	organization under the laws of this state is annually filed
21	by the institution with the state department.

23	(ii) A home-based educational program as defined

2 (iii) Aircraft flight training schools approved 3 and authorized by the federal aviation agency of the United 4 States of America; or 5 6 (iv) A nondegree granting school teaching 7 techniques of outdoor recreation, leadership, ecology or conservation domiciled in the state of Wyoming. 8 9 10 (b) Any post secondary education degree granting 11 institution not accredited by an accreditation association 12 recognized by the United States department of education and 13 which is not exempt under subparagraph (a) (i) (B) of this 14 section shall as required by W.S. 21-2-401(a), obtain a license under this article prior to operating or doing 15 16 business in this state. The institution may conduct 17 organizational activities and start up preparations before obtaining the license required under W.S. 21-2-401(a), but 18 19 shall not accept any tuition, application fees or any 20 similar monies from any prospective student before 21 obtaining the license.

23 **21-4-101. Definitions.**

1 (a) For the purposes of this article:

2

3 (iv) "Parochial, church or religious school" is 4 one operated under the auspices or control of a local 5 church or religious congregation or a denomination established to promote and promulgate the commonly held 6 7 religious doctrines of the group though it may also include basic academic subjects in its curriculum. 8 Nothing contained in W.S. 21-4-102 (b)  $\frac{21-2-401}{100}$  or  $\frac{21-2-406}{100}$  grants 9 10 to the state of Wyoming or any of its officers, agencies or 11 subdivisions any right or authority to control, manage, 12 supervise or make any suggestions as to the control, management or supervision of any parochial, church or 13 religious school; 14

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
