1	AN ACT relating to law enforcement retirement; authorizing
2	specified employees at state parks and historic sites to

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9	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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11	Section 1. W.S. 9-3-402(a)(xviii) is amended to read:
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13	9-3-402. Definitions.

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2	(a) As used in this article:
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4	(xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer"
5	means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county
6	sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized
7	investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the
8	specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), any
9	superintendent, assistant superintendent or full-time park
10	ranger of any state park or historic site meeting the
11	<pre>specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(G), investigator</pre>
12	employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and
13	professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S.
14	7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, Wyoming
15	law enforcement academy instructor, University of Wyoming
16	campus police officer, detention officer or dispatcher for
17	law enforcement agencies;
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19	Section 2.
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(a) Coverage of superintendents, assistant 21 22 superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or historic sites under W.S. 9-3-432 as provided by section 1 23 of this act shall not be implemented by the Wyoming 24

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retirement board until funds payable to the Wyoming 1 2 system are received for deposit into retirement the 3 retirement account, as necessary for maintaining the 4 actuarial integrity of the account and funding all 5 liability arising under this act, for years of service prior to the date of entry or expansion of coverage. 6

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(b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section, 8 9 W.S. 9-3-432, with respect to superintendents, assistant 10 superintendents or full-time park rangers of state parks or 11 historic sites, shall not be implemented by the Wyoming 12 retirement board until funds necessary for maintaining the 13 actuarial integrity of the account and funding any liability arising under this act, are deposited into the 14 Wyoming retirement account by the Wyoming department of 15 state parks and cultural resources, and contributions 16 17 required under W.S. 9-3-432(a) and (b) are paid to the Wyoming retirement system for deposit into the retirement 18 account for at least two (2) months of covered service 19 20 following the date of entry of coverage, as applicable.

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22 Section 3. There is appropriated three hundred fifty 23 thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) from the general fund to the 24 department of state parks and cultural resources to be

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deposited in the retirement account as required by section 1 2 2 of this act to fund the liability arising under this act 3 for the coverage of superintendents, assistant 4 superintendents and full-time park rangers of state parks 5 or historic sites as provided in section 1 of this act. 6 7 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 8 9 (END)
