Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 35-21-120(a) by creating new paragraph (xii) and W.S. 33-21-122(c)(xxiii) are amended to

read:

(a) As used in this act:

1	(xii) "Geriatric assistant" means a certified
2	nursing assistant additionally trained and certified by the
3	board to provide specialized tasks and services for
4	residents of nursing care facilities;

6	(xiii) "Medication assistant" mean a certified
7	nursing assistant additionally trained and certified by the
8	board to administer oral, topical or transdermal
9	medications to residents or patients in health care
10	<pre>facilities;</pre>

12	(xii) (xiv) "This act" means W.S. 33-21-119
13	through 33-21-157.

15	33-21-122. Board of nursing; powers and duties.

17	(c) Without limiting the foregoing, the board of
18	nursing may do the following:

20	(xxiii) By board rule and regulation, regulate
21	the qualifications, certification, recertification,
22	examination and discipline of nursing assistant and nurse
23	aides, geriatric assistants and medication assistants. For
24	purposes of carrying out this paragraph, fingerprints and

other information necessary for a criminal history record 1

2 background check pursuant to W.S. 7-19-201 shall be

provided to the board. Board rules and regulations under 3

4 this paragraph shall be no more stringent than federal

5 rules and regulations.
