A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Health Insurance Pool Act;
2 and providing for an effective date.

4 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6 **Section 1.** W.S. 26-43-106(b)(iii) and (iv) and
7 26-43-113 are amended to read:

9 **26-43-106. Minimum benefits; limitations.**

11 (b) In establishing the pool coverage, the
12 commissioner shall:

14 (iii) For pool coverage other than coverage
15 under the alternative plan provide that aggregate out-of-

1 pocket payments for eligible expenses in a policy year by
2 the insured in the form of deductibles and coinsurance
3 shall not be:

4
5 (A) Less than ~~two thousand five hundred~~
6 ~~dollars (\$2,500.00)~~ three thousand seven hundred fifty
7 dollars (\$3,750.00) or more than ~~five thousand dollars~~
8 ~~(\$5,000.00)~~ seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00)
9 per individual; or

11 (B) Less than ~~five thousand dollars~~
12 ~~(\$5,000.00)~~ seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00)
13 or more than ~~ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)~~ fifteen
14 thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) per family.

16 (iv) For pool coverage under the alternative
17 plan, provide that aggregate out-of-pocket payments for
18 eligible expenses in a policy year by the insured in the
19 form of deductibles and coinsurance shall not be:

21 (A) More than ~~two thousand dollars~~
22 ~~(\$2,000.00)~~ three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) per
23 individual; or

1 (B) More than ~~four thousand dollars~~
2 ~~(\$4,000.00)~~ per family.
