(a) Under W.S. 19-15-101 through 19-15-103 1 no 2 expenditure of state funds shall be authorized by the 3 department unless the purchase is specifically for: 4 5 (i) Civil air patrol aviation education training aids, books and equipment; 6 7 (ii) Maintenance and hangar rent of "on-loan" 8 9 United States air force aircraft of two hundred fifty (250) 10 horsepower or less; and 11 12 (iii) Maintenance supplies and equipment for civil air patrol communications network and administrative 13 costs as may be approved by the department. 14 15 16 Section 2. W.S. 10-3-501 through 10-3-503 are 17 repealed. 18 19 Section 3. All supplies and equipment of the civil 20 air patrol owned by the state of Wyoming shall be 21 transferred to the military department. 22
