1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; applying the protections of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act 2 3 1940, as amended, to national guard members as specified; providing a penalty; specifying how the 4 5 protections may be used; specifying jurisdiction; providing definitions; making conforming amendments; and providing 6 for an effective date. 7

2	(a) Members of the Wyoming national guard ordered to
3	active state service by the state or federal government for
4	a period of more than thirty (30) consecutive days shall
5	have all protections afforded to persons in the military
6	service of the United States under the Soldiers' and
7	Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended (54 Stat.
8	1178, 50 App. U.S.C. 501 et seq.). Except as provided in
9	subsection (b) of this section, nothing in this subsection
10	shall be construed to authorize the imposition of any
11	penalty under the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act
12	of 1940, as amended, for violation of the protections
13	afforded to members of the Wyoming national guard pursuant
14	to this subsection. As used in this subsection, "active
15	state service" means as defined in W.S. 19-7-101(a)(v).

17	(b) Any person who knowingly violates the protections
18	provided to members of the Wyoming national guard pursuant
19	to subsection (a) of this section shall be guilty of a
20	misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand
21	dollars (\$1,000.00).

23	(a) (c) The protections afforded to members of the
