- 14 (a) Any person shall have the right to acquire by
- 15 purchase, gift or lease the right to the use of water which
- 16 may be embraced in any adjudicated or valid unadjudicated

1 water right, or any portion thereof, for a period of not to 2 exceed two (2) years, for highway construction or repair, 3 railroad roadbed construction or repair, drilling and producing operations, municipal purposes or other temporary 4 purposes, on its own behalf or on behalf of its agents, 5 employees or contractors: provided, that if the proposed 6 7 use is to be for public highway construction or repair contract with 8 under а the state department 9 transportation, only the state transportation commission 10 shall have the authority to acquire the water; and the 11 state transportation commission shall have the sole and 12 continuing responsibility for the acquisition, including 13 the payment of all fees, royalties and other consideration 14 for the use of and access to water and the right to acquire the rights to use shall not be delegated to a construction 15 contractor or other third party; and further provided, that 16 17 any temporary transfer shall be allowed only if no other appropriator is injured thereby. 18
