6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 6-1-104(a)(vi) by creating a new
9	subparagraph (P) is amended to read:

11	6-1-104. Definitions.

13	(a) As used in W.S. 6-1-101 through 6-10-203 unless
14	otherwise defined:

16	(vi) "Peace officer" includes the following
17	officers assigned to duty in the state of Wyoming:

2	(P) Any superintendent, assistant
3	superintendent or full-time park ranger of any state park
4	or historic site who has qualified pursuant to W.S. 9-1-701
5	through 9-1-707, when acting within the boundaries of the
6	state park or historic site or when responding to a request
7	to assist other peace officers acting within the scope of
8	their official duties in their own jurisdiction.
9	
10	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
11	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
12	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
13	Constitution.
