A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state holidays; providing for the  
2 observance of Veterans Day as specified; and providing for  
3 an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-4-108 is created to read:

9 **8-4-108. Veterans Day.**

11 (a) In recognition of the many Wyoming citizens who  
12 have served in the armed forces of this country, November  
13 11 of each year is designated as "Veterans Day. The day  
14 shall be appropriately observed in the public schools of  
15 the state and by organizations within the state.

2           (b) The governor, not later than November 1 of each  
3 year, shall issue a proclamation requesting proper  
4 observance of Veterans Day and requesting military and  
5 veterans' organizations to work with the boards of all  
6 Wyoming school districts to conduct proper exercises in  
7 observation of the contributions and sacrifices of  
8 veterans.

10           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
