A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judicial salaries; increasing judicial
2 salaries as specified; providing for an appropriation; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-110(a)(i) through (iii) is
8 amended to read:

10 **5-1-110. Salaries of judges.**

11

12 (a) Subject to constitutional and statutory
13 provisions concerning when salaries can become effective,
14 judges of the supreme court, district courts and circuit
15 courts shall receive the following annual salaries which

1 shall be paid in equal monthly installments on the last
2 working day of the month:

4 (i) Supreme court justices shall receive an
5 annual salary of ~~one hundred five thousand dollars~~
6 ~~(\$105,000.00)~~ one hundred eight thousand two hundred
7 dollars (\$108,200.00) commencing July 1, 2004, and one
8 hundred eleven thousand four hundred dollars (\$111,400.00)
9 commencing July 1, 2005;

10

11 (ii) District court judges shall receive an
12 annual salary of ~~one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00)~~
13 one hundred three thousand dollars (\$103,000.00) commencing
14 July 1, 2004, and one hundred six thousand one hundred
15 dollars (\$106,100.00) commencing July 1, 2005;

16

17 (iii) Circuit court judges shall receive an
18 annual salary of, ~~eighty two thousand dollars (\$82,000.00)~~
19 eighty-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$84,500.00)
20 commencing July 1, 2004, and eighty-seven thousand dollars
21 (\$87,000.00) commencing July 1, 2005.

23 **Section 2.** In addition to any other appropriation to
24 the supreme court, there is appropriated from the general

1 fund to the supreme court five hundred forty-four thousand
2 five hundred fifty-one dollars (\$544,551.00) to implement
3 the salary formula for judges established under this act.

5 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
