- 1 AN ACT relating to veterans; providing an appropriation for
- 2 the development of a master plan for the Oregon Trail state
- 3 veteran's cemetery; requiring a report; and providing for
- 4 an effective date.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** There is appropriated from the general
- 9 fund to the adjutant general nineteen thousand four hundred
- 10 fifty dollars (\$19,450.00) for the development of a master
- 11 plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's cemetery. The
- 12 plan shall be developed in accordance with federal
- 13 requirements to allow for reimbursement of expenditures for
- 14 the development, expansion and operation of the cemetery.
- 15 To the extent reimbursement is available, the adjutant
- 16 general shall apply to appropriate federal agencies for

1 reimbursement of expenditures for the development of the

2 master plan. Any reimbursement of expenditures made under

3 this section shall be deposited with the state treasurer to

4 be placed in the general fund.

5

6 **Section 2.** The adjutant general shall report to the

7 joint transportation and highways interim committee not

8 later than September 15, 2004, regarding the development of

9 a master plan for the Oregon Trail state veteran's

10 cemetery. The report shall include a timeline for future

11 expansion and development, anticipated costs for each phase

12 of expansion and development and the available funding

13 sources for expansion and development.

15 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

18 Constitution.
