## A BILL for

AN ACT relating to public utilities; limiting the amount that may be charged for late payment of bills for water services; making conforming amendments; providing a definition; and providing for an effective date. Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 37-3-116 is created to read:

## 37-3-116. Water services; late payment fees.

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a delinquency charge or other fee for the late payment of a bill for water services shall not exceed the greater of:
(i) Two percent (2\%) of the unpaid amount of the

bill; or
```

(ii) Five dollars (\$5.00).
(b) For the purposes of this section, "water services" means the supply, storage, distribution or furnishing to or for the public of water for manufacturing, municipal, agriculture or domestic uses.

Section 2. W.S. 15-7-101(a)(iii)(C) is amended to read:

## 15-7-101. Purposes.

(a) In addition to all other powers provided by law, any city or town may make public improvements as follows for which bonds may be issued to the contractor or be sold as provided in this chapter to:
(iii) Take any action necessary to establish, purchase, extend, maintain and regulate a water system for supplying water to its inhabitants and for any other public purposes, including:

(C) Enacting ordinances for their enforcement and collection, provided that a delinquency charge or other fee for the late payment of a bill for water services shall be subject to the limitations of W.S. 37-3-116.
