17	require a legislative appropriation either directly or

1 indirectly, excluding the secretary of state, auditor, 2 treasurer, superintendent of public instruction, the 3 Wyoming highway department of transportation and the game 4 and fish departments department, in submitting budget 5 estimates or requests for funds, or for instituting, reporting financial and budget 6 recording and all 7 transactions of the state. 8 9-2-1012. Duties of budget division; transmittal of 9 10 standard budget and manual; return of completed exception and expanded budgets; submission to governor; disposition 11 12 general fund appropriations; submission of of excess 13 selected budget information to joint appropriations interim 14 committee. 15 16 Except for the budgets of the secretary of state, (C) 17 auditor, treasurer and superintendent of public instruction, the governor may, upon examining the budget 18 estimates and requests and after consultation with each 19 20 agency, approve, disapprove, alter or revise the estimates 21 in accordance with applicable state and federal laws.

9	and his recommendations and conclusions, and the
10	recommendations of the secretary of state, auditor,
