1 19-7-401. Wyoming military assistance trust fund;

2 establishment of trust fund; corpus inviolate; investment

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5 (a) An account within the trust and agency fund is

6 established which shall be referred to as the Wyoming

7 military assistance trust fund. The trust fund shall

8 consist of those funds designated to the account by law.

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10 monies deposited into the trust (b) The 11 established pursuant to this section are inviolate and 12 constitute a permanent or perpetual trust fund. The monies 13 shall be transmitted to the state treasurer for credit to 14 the trust fund and shall be invested by the state treasurer as authorized under W.S. 9-4-711 in a manner to obtain the 15 16 highest return possible consistent with the preservation of 17 the corpus. The interest earned from investment of the corpus of the trust fund shall be annually credited by the 18 state treasurer not later than June 30 of each year into a 19 20 separate account within the trust and agency fund and

assistance trust fund created by W.S. 19-7-401 shall be 3

9 has been called to active duty;

12 military reserve unit that is not based in Wyoming, if the

6 to assist eligible military personnel and families deal

- 4 records and available for inspection as provided by W.S.

- 7 shall be available for inspection only by the governor and

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- 14 Section 2. Effective July 1, 2004, there is
- 15 appropriated ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the
- 16 budget reserve account to the military assistance trust
- 17 fund created by this act.

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19 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
