9 Section 1.

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- 11 (a) There is created the joint legislative and
- 12 executive task force on capitol facilities.

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14 (b) The task force shall be comprised of:

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16 (i) The governor or his designee;

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(ii) The secretary of state or his designee; 1 2 3 (iii) The state treasurer or her designee; 4 5 (iv) The state auditor or his designee; 6 7 state superintendent of public (v) The instruction or his designee; 8 9 10 (vi) The president, vice president, majority and minority floor leaders of the Wyoming senate; 11 12 13 (vii) The speaker, speaker pro tempore, majority and minority floor leaders of the Wyoming house of 14 representatives; and 15 16 17 (viii) The two (2) legislative liaisons to the building commission and the chairman of the 18 state appropriations committee of the house of representatives. 19 20 (c) The senate president shall serve as chairman of 21 22 the task force. 23

24 (d) The task force shall:

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2 (i) Conduct a comprehensive review of space

3 requirements of the state-wide elected officials and the

4 legislature;

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6 (ii) Review previous reports and studies

7 consider space allocation alternatives including the

possible relocation of offices and the lease, purchase or 8

construction of additional facilities; 9

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11 (iii) Develop maintenance, repair

12 restoration priorities for the state capitol and existing

facilities within the capitol complex; 13

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15 (iv) Develop both long and short term proposals

for addressing space requirements both in the state capitol 16

17 building and in the capitol complex;

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19 (v) Periodically report their findings

20 recommendations to the state building commission,

21 legislative management council and the joint appropriations

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22 interim committee;

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(vi) Submit specific project recommendations to 1 2 building commission for state approval the and 3 authorization of funding; and 4 5 (vii) Recommend to the management council statutory changes that may be required to implement project 6 7 recommendations. 8 Staff support for the task force 9 (e) shall provided by the legislative service office and by any state 10 11 agency upon request. 12 13 Section 2. 14 (a) Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) 15 appropriated from the general fund to the legislative 16 17 service office to fund the interim meetings and activities of the task force and to contract with appropriate 18 professionals as necessary to complete the task force 19 20 study. Expenditure of funds under this subsection shall be 21 subject to management council approval. 22 23 Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00)

is appropriated from the general fund to the state building

1 commission to be used to implement projects recommended by

2 the task force and approved by the commission.

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4 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

7 Constitution.
