(h) Notwithstanding W.S. 9-3-422, any law enforcement 1 2 officer in service for which contributions have been paid 3 because of illness or injury in the scope of employment, or 4 except as otherwise provided under this subsection, any law 5 enforcement officer with ten (10) years of service credit under this article because of illness or injury outside of 6 the scope of employment, may retire on account of a total 7 partial disability in accordance with rules and 8 or 9 regulations adopted by the board. Any law enforcement 10 officer previously covered under W.S. 15-5-301 through 11 15-5-314 and transferred under this article may because of 12 illness or injury outside the scope of employment and 13 regardless of the number of years of service credit under 14 this article, retire on account of total or partial disability. The board shall determine mental or physical 15 incapacitation for disability retirement under this section 16 17 in accordance with W.S. 9-3-422(a) and rules and regulation of the board, and the cost of any required examination or 18 test shall be paid as provided by W.S. 9-3-422 and rule and 19 regulation of the board. Any law enforcement officer 20 21 receiving a disability benefit under this section is 22 subject to reporting, evaluation and excess earnings deduction requirements imposed under W.S. 9-3-423 and rule 23 24 and regulation of the board. disability as determined and for which a member qualifies 1 2 under this section, a law enforcement officer shall for the life of the officer or until the officer is no longer 3 4 disabled, receive: 5 6 9-3-611. Eligibility and amount of disability allowance. 7 8 9 (d) Disability allowances shall be as follows: 10 11 (i) fifty percent (50%) of highest average salary 12 for duty-connected or ordinary total or partial 13 disability.; 14 15 (ii) Forty-two and one-half percent (42.5%) of highest average salary for duty-connected partial 16 disability; and 17 18 19 (iii) Thirty-five percent (35%) of highest 20 average salary for ordinary partial disability. 21 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2004. 22 23 24 (END)
